



Normal Heart Tissue



8 – 12 Hours After Myocardial Infarction (MI)


Increased number of black dots indicates inflammation.




2 – 4 Days After MI Shows Loss of Muscle Tissue




Normal Lung Tissue



Coronary Artery Reference Slide




Normal Coronary Artery with blood in the center and the artery wall surrounding it.
